### 2. OFFICIAL INVITATION

The official invitation is attached as Form A\* with this bulletin. The deadline to submit the intention of participation is on or before **22 January 2024.** 

All other official forms will be sent in due course.

This Championship is open to all current and <u>paid-up member federation of the Asian Seniors Bowling Council (ASBC).</u> The annual ASBC membership fee is USD\$200 which will be collected at the Team Manager's meeting.

Athletes MUST be fifty (50) years old or above (Born in or before 1974) for Senior Division and sixty-five (65) years old or above (Born in or before 1959) for the Grand Senior Division.

Each member federation of the Asian Seniors Bowling Council may enter a four (4) Men's Team and four (4) Women's Team for the Seniors Division and a maximum of four (4) Men's Team and four (4) Women's Team for the Grand Senior Division, as determined by the host federation. Each Team shall be represented by a team of four (4) athletes. More teams from a country may be allowed if registration is NOT full capacity. **Closing date** for registration is 13 July 2024.

\*Please return Form A even if your federation does not intend to participate in the 17th Asian Seniors Bowling Championships.

### 6. ENTRY INTO SINGAPORE & VISA REQUIREMENTS

Most visitors to Singapore do not require a visa for entry. For a list of countries that require a valid Visa for entry into Singapore, you can check the <a href="mailto:lmmigration-&-Checkpoints-Authority">lmmigration & Checkpoints</a> <a href="mailto:Authority">Authority (ICA)'s website</a>, or enquire at the <a href="mailto:Singapore Overseas Mission">Singapore Overseas Mission</a> closest to you. <a href="mailto:Alternatively">Alternatively</a>, you may write in to <a href="mailto:ICA\_SAVE\_Helpdesk@ica.gov.sg">ICA\_SAVE\_Helpdesk@ica.gov.sg</a> with a copy of your travel document biodata page and front cover for further assistance and verification.

To enter Singapore, all travellers:

- must have minimum 6-month passport validity if you are not a Singapore passport holder
- must fill in the <u>SG Arrival Card (SGAC declaration)</u> up to 3 days before arrival. \*SGAC is not a visa.
- Only Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and Long-Term Pass Holders

entering via land checkpoints do not need to fill in the SGAC Security and Immigration Processes on Arrival

- Ensure that you do not bring prohibited items into Singapore
- Familiarise yourself with <u>immigration/customs clearance procedures</u>, including whether you are eligible for automated clearance
- Short-Term travellers should have sufficient cash and proof of onward travel (tickets, visas), and ensure that you do not stay beyond your visit pass validity. You may retrieve your e-Pass after arrival using the e-Pass Enquiry Portal or check your visit pass validity using the visit pass validity tool.

### 7. FEES

### **Entry Fee for Delegation**

The 17th Asian Seniors Bowling Championships entry fee is US\$230 per person for all players, coaches and administrators as well as any extra person in the Official Delegation. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, participation in Opening Ceremony and Welcome Reception as well as the Victory Banquet.

### Entry Fee for Guests/Supporters

The entry fee for guests and supporters is <a href="US\$180">US\$180</a> per person for those travelling with the team. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation to Official Hotel and venue, entry into bowling venue and participation in the Opening Ceremony and Welcome Reception as well as Closing Ceremony.

### **Press Officials**

Unless they have other duties (another capacity) related to a team or federation at the 17th Asian Seniors Bowling Championships, there will be **no entry fee** for accredited press officials.

### 8. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be provided free of charge to and from airport upon arrival and departure for all Teams staying in Official Hotel. Transportation will be provided for teams traveling between official hotel and tournament venue according to the transport schedule (to be furnished nearer to date of competition).
