Masters Event

1. This event is open to those bowlers who have competed and completed a total of 9 games, made up of 3 series of 3 games.
2. The qualifying scores will be based on total from 3 series of 3 games.
3. In the event of a tie for the last position in the qualifying round, a one game roll-off will serve as a tie breaker.
4. All qualifiers must check with the Tournament Directors 24 hours before their finals roll-off, to confirm their fixtures and to check for any changes in the schedule.
5. Any matter not covered in the rules will be deal with by the Tournament Directors or the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final and binding subject to appeal to the TTBA Council and the ABF Executive Council.

7. Graded Masters—The top 20 male qualifiers and top 12 female qualifiers shall play a 12 games series with lane movement after every game with positioning on the last game. The top three (3) finishers in each division shall be declared Graded A Masters Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The finals on Saturday April 17, 2010 at 9.00 am. Personal check in time before 8.30 am. Games Fee-baht 1,800.
8. Men Grade B Master-The top 20 male qualifiers shall play a 8 games series with lane movement after every game and positioning on the last game. The top three (3) finishers in each division shall be declared Grade "B" Masters Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up respectively. The finals on Sunday April 18, 2010 at 09.00 am. Personal check in time before 08.30 am. Games Fee-baht 1,600.

9. Ladies' Open Masters

WOMEN'S OPEN MASTERS

Round 1

The 16 Masters Finalists (as listed above) will play 8 games on Saturday 17, 2010 at 2.00 pm. Personal check in 1.30 pm. Top 7 bowlers based on total pin falls after the round will qualify for Round 2.

Round 2

At 6.00 pm. Personal check in at 5.30 pm.

8 Games will be played. Top 7 bowlers from Round 1, top 2 qualifiers from Local pool and top 3 qualifiers from the Overseas Pool will play 8 games on scratch. Top 6 at the end of the 8 games based on total pin falls will qualify for Round 3 (Quarter Finals)



Round 3 (Quarter Finals)

3 games will be played. Top 4 bowlers based on total pin falls after the round will qualified to the Semi-Finals

Round 4 (Semi Finals)

Will play on Sunday April 18,2010. Roll off 2.00 pm. check in before 1.30 pm. Best of 3 games matches will be played between highest seed bowlers vs lowest seed bowlers. Winners will proceed to Round 5 (Finals)

Round 5 (Finals)

Best of 3 games will be played between the two finalists. Winner will be declared as Champion and the opponent as 1st runner-up.

Players filing to qualify for the Masters Finals shall fill vacancies, which may exist at the start of Masters Round 1. Such vacancy or vacancies shall be filled from the non-qualifiers available at that time in the order of finish in the qualifying competition. In case of a tie between two or more available non-qualifiers, the selection will be decided by the last game of the qualified MQ.

All ranking for losing finalist from quarter final and semi final will based on the seeding on round 2 results.

10. Men's Open Masters

Round 1

The 36 Masters Finalists (as listed above) will play 8 games on Saturday 17, 2010. Top 12 bowlers based on total pin falls after the round will qualify for Round 2.

Round 2

8 Games will be played on scratch. Top 12 bowlers from Round 1, top 3 qualifiers from Local pool and top 3 qualifiers from the Overseas Pool will play 8 games on scratch. Top 8 at the end of the 8 games based on total pin falls will qualify for Round 3 (Quarter Finals)

Round 3 (Quarter Finals)

3 games will be played. Top 4 bowlers based on total pin falls after the round will qualified to the Semi-Finals

Round 4 (Semi Finals)

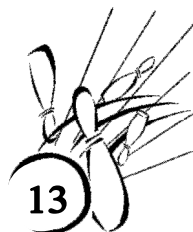
Sunday April 18, 2010 Roll off 2.00 pm. Check in 1.30 pm.

Best of 3 games matches will be played between highest seed bowlers vs lowest seed bowlers. Winners will proceed to Round 5 (Finals)

Round 5 (Finals)

Best of 3 games will be played between the two finalists. Winner will be declared as Champion and the opponent as 1st runner-up.

Players filing to qualify for the Masters Finals shall fill vacancies, which may exist at the start of Masters Round 1. Such vacancy or vacancies shall be filled from the non-qualifiers available at that time in the order of finish in the qualifying competition. In case of a tie between two or more available non-qualifiers, the selection will be decided by the last game of the qualified MQ.



11. Senior Master

This event is open to both male and female qualifiers who are at least 50 years old as of April 1st 2010. The top qualifiers shall play 6 games series with lane movement, Total pin-fall to decide the winners. The final will be held on Sunday April 18, 2010 at 09.00 am. Check in time before 08.30 am. Games fee Baht 1,200
