



Tournament Format

Qualification

6 games qualification (entries and re-entries)

Desperado squad

1 game

Composing Top 48

A: 3 players from a separate standing in the squads conducted on Saturday 6 December

B: 3 players from a separate standing in the squads conducted on Sunday 7 December

C: 38 players from the general standing including results from all qualification squads

D: 4 players from the desperado squad

Players are qualified from the categories in the order C - B - A

If any player is qualified both from B and C, then the next positioned in the B-standing will qualify. If any player is qualified both from A and B or C, then the next positioned in the A-standing will qualify

Qualification to Stage 1 Finals

Players qualified from the A-standing (3), the B-standing (3), the desperado (D) standing (4) and players positioned 13-38 in the general (C) standing (26) will qualify for the Stage 1 Finals.

Players positioned 7-12 in the general standing will qualify for the Stage 2 Finals.

Players positioned 1-6 in the general standing will qualify for the Stage 3 Finals.

Stage 1 Finals

36 players will play 6 games starting from scratch. Top 18 will qualify for the Stage 2 finals. Players not continuing to the Stage 2 finals will be ranked 31-48 according to their positions in the standing of the Stage 1 Finals.

Stage 2 Finals

24 players will play 6 games starting from scratch. Top 10 will qualify for the Stage 3 Finals. Players not continuing to the Stage 3 finals will be ranked 17-30 according to their positions in the standing of the Stage 2 Finals.

Stage 3 Finals

16 players will play 6 games starting from scratch. Top 8 will qualify for the Stage 4 Finals. Players not continuing to the Stage 4 Finals will be ranked 9-16 according to their positions in the standing of the Stage 3 Finals.

Stage 4 Finals

8 players will play 6 games with the pin fall from Stage 3 Finals carried forward. Top 4 will qualify for the Stage 5 Finals, seeded 1-4. Players not continuing to the Stage 5 Finals will be ranked 5-8 according to their positions in the standing of the Stage 4 Finals.

Stage 5 Finals

2 matches (seeded 1 vs. seeded 4 and seeded 2 vs. seeded 3), 2 games total painfalls. The 2 winners will continue to the Stage 6 Finals. The 2 losers will be ranked 3-4 according to their seeding.

Stage 6 Finals

1 match, 2 games total painfalls. The loser will be ranked 2 and the winner will be declared the Champion.

Tournament Tie Rules**Qualification the Stage 1-4 Finals**

In case of a tie, the highest ranked player will be the player with the highest last game. If a tie still exists, the highest ranked player will be the player with the highest second last game, then the player with the highest third last game etc.

Stage 5-6 Finals

In case of a tie in a match, a one ball roll off on a full set of pins will be played, repeated until the tie is broken.

Desperado

In case of tie in the desperado squad, the highest positioned player will be the player with the highest position after the qualification.
