JAKARTA SUPER CLASSIC 2009 GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

OBJECTIVES

This International Tournament is organized by PBI for overseas and local bowlers to foster and promote goodwill, comradeship, friendship and sportsmanship amongst the bowling fraternity.

SANCTIONS

This tournament is sanctioned by PBI and ABF (Asian Bowling Federation). All PBI, and WTBA playing rules shall apply.

ELIIBILITY

All current members of PBI member clubs of good standing and foreign bowlers accredited by their respective Congress/Federation/Association are eligible to participate in this tournament

AVERAGE

For members of the Indonesian Bowling Congress (PBI-Jaya) only PBI's official 2nd – 2009 Quarter average ranking will be used. An entrant who has no PBI's official 2nd Quarter average ranking will use his/her PBI's official 1st Quarter average ranking. An entrant who has no established average must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective PBI-Provinces offices.

Overseas bowlers must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective Associations or Congresses.

HANDICAP

Handicap will be added during qualifying round, Semi-Final and Grand Final Stage.

New bowlers without an established average PBI must use an average of 196 for men and 186 for ladies.

FORMAT/SQUAD TIME

This is a singles classic event and is open to the first 180 bowlers.

The 180 bowlers will be divided into 3 squads of 60 bowler each (4 bowlers to pair of lanes).

Squad A – 60 bowlers

Squad B – 60 bowlers

Squad C – 60 bowlers

19/10/09 Sunday.

Registration of bowling balls and practice sessions.

P/S: Practice session at bowlers' own account.

Qualifying round will be over 24 games conducted over 3 days and bowled in 3 blocks of 8 games per block.

SEMI FINALS

The top 30 bowlers after the qualifying rounds will then bowl in the Finals over 8 games, based on total pin falls with h'cap will advance to the finals. The top 4 bowlers of this final will move on to the Step Ladder Grand Finals

STEP LADDER GRAND FINALS

The Grand Finals is on a Step Ladder format which is as follows:

Match #1

4th placed bowler shall play the 3rd placed bowler in a one game roll-off, total pin falls with h'cap.

Match #2

The winner of Match #1 shall play the 2nd placed bowler in a one game roll-off, total pin with h'cap.

Match #3

The winner of Match #2 shall play the 1st placed bowler over one game, total pin falls with h'cap. If the game is won by the 1st placed bowler, he/she shall be declared the Champion. If the challenger wins, one more game shall be played, total pin falls with h'cap again. The winner of this game shall be declared the Champion.

In all the above 3 matches, each bowler shall bowl 2 frames at a time with the bowler drawn on the left lane to bowl first and he/she bowls only one frame. The bowler on the right lane will then bowl 2 frames, one on each adjoining lane, to be followed by his/her opponent in similar fashion until the game is completed. The second game shall be played like the first, with the bowler finishing on the left lane to bowl first and to bowl only one frame.

The loser of Match #1 shall be declared 4th position, the loser of Match #2 shall be declared 3rd position and loser of Match #3 will be declared 2nd position. For position 5th to 30th, the position shall be determined by the total pin falls with h'cap bowled in the Semi Finals.

ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE.

- 1. All entries must be submitted on prescribed forms available. Entry forms not completely and/or legibly filled may be disqualified.
- 2. The entry fee for the whole Tournament is Rp. 2.200.000,- per bowler (inclusive of game fees).
- 3. No entry is reserved unless a deposit of Rp.1000.000,- is accompanied per entry. Deposit is neither refundable nor transferable.
- Closing date: 19 October 2009.
 Entries received after the closing date are acceptable subject to availability of squad.
- 5. Since this is a singles event and only open to 180 bowlers, entries will be based on first-come-first-serve basis or the closing date which ever comes first.

REFUND

No REFUND OF entry fees will be made after it has been paid and the entry has been registered and accepted. Any participants who fail to show up and/or are late for checking in for the scheduled squad will be disqualified and the entry fees forfeited.

AWARDS

Prizes in the form of cash will be awarded to the top 30 bowlers in the tournament

CHECKING-IN

All participants must check-in by 6.00pm on 19 October 2009. overseas participants not arriving on time must confirm the arrival 24 hours iin advance failing which the Tournament Manager or in his absence his appointed official(s) on duty reserves the right to call in bowlers on waiting list.

REPORTING TIME

The Bowling Center's clock shall be the offial tiem piece. Notwithstanding any elays in running the squad, all participants are to check in 30 minutes before scheduled time to bowl.

Any tardy bowlers joining in the Squad/Semi Finals/Grand Finals will assume their participation as follows:

- 1. After briefing will join in the Squad without briefing
- 2. After warm-up will join in the Squad without warm up.
- 3. Roll off will commence his/her game at the frame which the bowler/s of his/her respective lanes has/have bowled.

No reserves will be called up for the Semi Final/Grand Final of this Tournament. In the event of absenteeism/s the Tournament Manager shall determine the appointment of pacers as he/she sees fit.

DRESS CODE (BOWLER'S ATTIRE)

Bowlers are required to be properly dressed for bowling. If in the opinion of the Tournament Manager or his/her appointed official on duty a bowler is not properly and appropriately dressed he/she may not be permitted to bowl.

In the event of TV coverage, It is the prerogative of the Tournament Manager to nominate/stipulate the attire to be worn.

VERIFICATION OF SCORES

It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the correctness of each game bowled by signing on the official result sheet which will be used as the official score recorded. Once signed, the scores shall stand, unless otherwise decided by the Tournament Manager. In the event the official score sheet is not signed for any reason, the Tournament Manager reserves the right to refuse acceptance of the result sheet.

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE

- 1. Should a tie occur in the last qualifying position in the Qualifying Rounds and Semi-Finals, the tiebreaker should be determined by Last High Game Scratch. This will be used and repeated until the tie(s) is/are broken.
- 2. Should a tie occur in the Grand Final, the 9th and 10th frames roll-off will take place and/or repeated until the winner is determine.

PACERS

No pacers will be allowed throughout the Tournament unless appointed by the Tournament Manager of his/her appointed official on duty.

SLOW BOWLING

Bowlers who are in readiness to step on the approach to deliver a ball shall have the following rights and obligations:

- 1. They may claim the right of way over anyone moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lame immediately on their left.
- 2. They should give way to any bowler who is moving towards the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately on their right.
- 3. Bowler shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn an shall not delay going to the approach if the lanes immediately adjacent to them on the left and right sides are clear.

INTERRUPTED GAME(S)

- 1. The Tournament Manager or his appointed official on duty may authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the starting lanes, would delay the normal progress of the series. An interrupted game and series which cannot be completed must resume from the point of interruption.
- 2. In the event that any scores of games being lost/erased and are not able to be recalled due to power failure (black-out), the bowler concerned will be required to re-bowl a new game when the power supply is resumed. However, all scores of completed game that have been recorded on the Master Score Sheets shall remain unchanged.

BOWLING ON WRONG LANE

When the bowler bowls on the wrong lanes(s) and the error is discovered before another bowler has bowled, a dead ball shall be declared and the bowler(s) will be required to rebowl on the correct lane(s). if the error is not discovered until the opposing bowler has bowled, the score shall count and the bowler will be required to bowl his subsequent frame(s) on the wrong lane.

PROTES

- 1. <u>Scores</u>: Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 12 hours of the event. In the case of the last match of the Step-Ladder Grand Finals of the Master event, such protest, if any should be addressed to the same officials before prize presentation. No protest made after the prize presentation will be entertained.
- 2. **Foul**: Must be brought to the attention of the Lane Marshall before the delivery of the next ball. No complaints made after the 2nd ball has been bowled shall be entertained.
- 3. <u>Eligibility</u>: Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 24 hours of the first infringement or before the next round or prize presentation or whichever is earlier.

SPECIAL NOTES

- 1. Bowlers are requested to refrain from swearing on the lanes.
- 2. Bowlers shall restrict themselves to their respective lanes and exercise consideration for all participants.
- 3. Bowlers wearing soft rubber soles on their non-sliding foot may be barred from further bowling subject, to the scrutiny of the Tournament Directors.
- 4. Bowlers are not allowed to sand or apply any form of liquid or chemical on the surface of bowling balls during any block of competition.
- 5. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to accept or reject any entry they deem fit.
- 6. Any matters arising and not covered in these Tournament Rules will be decided by the Tournament Chairman, the Tournament Directors or the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final subject only to an appeal to the PBI. Such appeal should be made in writing and within 48 hours of the decision by any of the above. Notwithstanding the above, an appeal FOR THE DECISION OF THE PBI may still be lodged with the FIQ WTBA Asian Zone but through the Indonesian Bowling Congress and within 30 days of the PBI'S decision.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the host federation to circulate to the participating federations all technical information including the program setting of the oiling machine, the oiling pattern graph, brand of oiling machine, type of oil and cleaner used.

SMOKING AND DRINKING

- The Players must not use tobacco products, consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while in competition; i.e. during the entire period of a block of games. In those instances where it is established that a player is in breach of this rule, he may be suspended by the Tournament Technical Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played.
- Non-alcoholic beverages are allowed provided they not consumed in the player's area.
- During the championships alcoholic beverages may not be served or consumed in the player's area or the spectator's area.
- During championships smoking is not permitted in the bowling centre. However, it may
 be allowed in a closed area, provided it does not affect the environment in the player's
 and spectator's area.

INTERPRETATION CLAUSE.

The Tournament Manager or his in his absence his appointed official(s) on duty reserve(s) the right to accept or reject any entry(s) as he deems fit. Any matter arising which is not covered in these Tournament Rules and Regulation will be decided by the Tournament Manager whose decision shall be final subject only to appeal to PBI. Such an appeal must be made in writing within 48 hours of the decision of the Tournament Manager.
