Average 190 or under (need for each National Federation Certificate)

3) Youth Boy Division : Boys who born in 2002 and after (under 18) only4) Youth Girl Division : Girls who born in 2002 and after (under 18) only

3. Qualification Round Format

1) Open Division : 3G/squad. The best 3-squad score (9G) will be qualification

Qualification will be given based on total score

Multiple squads can be attempted

Handicap: Women's +7/G. No handicap for Seniors

2) Grade Division : 3/G squad. The best 3-squad score (9G) will be qualification

Qualification will be given based on total score

Multiple squads can be attempted

Handicap: Women's +7/G. No handicap for Seniors

3) Youth Boy Division : Boys who born in 2002 and after (under 18)

3G/squad. The best 2-squad score (6G) will be qualification

Qualification will be given based on total score

Multiple squads can be attempted

4) Youth Girl Division : Girls who born in 2002 and after (under 18)

3G/squad. The best 2-squad score (6G) will be qualification

Qualification will be given based on total score

Multiple squads can be attempted

5. Entry and Final Round Format

1) Open Division (Total 115 qualifiers : Squad A 58 qualifiers, Squad B 57 qualifiers / two squads will be running. A squad 20, B squad 20)

Top 40 qualifiers will proceed to the Final Round

Local qualifying Top 1,2,3 qualifiers, Overseas qualifying Top 1,2,3 qualifiers will proceed to the Semi-final

8G/day Top 20 from each squad (Total score Top 40) will proceed to the Semi-final Semi-final 45 qualifiers 6G Top 6 for TV Final Round

Stepladder Finals to declare winner

Open Division (Total 115 qualifiers : Squad A 58 qualifiers, Squad B 57 qualifiers / two squads will be running. A squad 20, B squad 20)

Top 40 qualifiers will proceed to the Final Round

Local qualifying Top 1,2,3 qualifiers, Overseas qualifying Top 1,2,3 qualifiers will proceed to the Semi-final

8G/day Top 20 from each squad (Total score Top 40) will proceed to the Semi-final Semi-final 45 qualifiers will bowl 6G. Top 6 will proceed to TV Final Round Stepladder Finals to declare the winner

- 2) Grade Division: The top 44 qualifiers will bowl 6G. Top 2 will proceed to TV Final Round Stepladder Finals to declare the winner
- 3) Youth Boy Division : The top 20 qualifiers will bowl 6G. Top 2 will proceed to TV Final Round Stepladder Finals to declare the winner
- 4) Youth Girl Division : The top 10 qualifiers will bowl 6G. Top 2 will proceed to TV Final Round Stepladder Finals to declare the winner

6. Registration Fee

Open Division : 50,000 won/person
 Grade Division : 30,000 won/person
 Youth Division : 20,000 won/person

7. Qualifying Entry Fee

Open Division : 45,000 won/squad (3G)
 Grade Division : 35,000 won/squad (3G)
 Youth Division : 25,000 won/squad (3G)

4) Desperado : 100,000 won/game (Maximum 60 people by order of arrival)

8. Final Round Entry Fee

5) Open Division : 200,000 won
 6) Grade Division : 100,000 won
 7) Youth Division : 80,000 won

9. Registration

1) Qualifying Round : Register by each squad by order of arrival at the stadium

During the tournament, reservation can be made at the venue

(After the reservation, refund is not available)

2) Final Round : After final entries, register on site and deposit to designated account

10. Tax Deduction

Withholding tax for 3.3% of all prize money

Withholding tax for 13.3% of prize money for all overseas bowlers

- Bowlers who receives the prize must enter personal information for tax deduction at the HQ to receive the prize money. It will be deposited to the bowler's real name account
- Tax deduction for local bowlers may change
- 11. Ball inspection fee is 1,000 won per ball.

▶ Game Rule

1) Verification of Scores

It is the responsibility of each of the bowler to verify the correctness of each game on the official score sheet to accurately confirm the applicant's obligation to sign.

2) Interrupted Games

- 2.1 Tournament Director can approve the delayed game and ending situation from equipment failure
- 2.2 If the match game history is lost and deleted because of the issue of equipment failure or power supply, Tournament Director's discretion can start a new game after rearranging the equipment

3) Registration of Bowling Ball, Illegality and Disqualification

All bowlers are advised to check that their bowling balls used in the tournament are certified as legal for weight and other specifications. If any time a bowler is found to have used an illegal ball even if previously certified legal by the Tournament Office, he/she shall be disqualified from the entire tournament. If the Tournament Committee is of the opinion that such usage was deliberate and was intended to cheat, he/she will be obligated to return immediately any awards that may have already been given to him/her

4) Altering Bowling Ball Surface

Altering the surface of bowling balls is allowed in a designated area during the official practice session, during the practice session immediately preceding a competition round. A player may not alter the surface of the bowling ball during a block of games. If altering the surface of the bowling ball is done, the game will be set to zero

5) Tie-Breaking Procedure

- 5.1 Qualifying Round
 - 1) Bowlers without handicap is the qualifier
 - 2) Qualifier who has the smallest difference in total pin falls of the 3 squads
 - 3) Ties
 - a) The bowler with the lowest 9 games high / low deviation becomes qualifier
 - b) The bowler with the high score in 9 games becomes qualifier
 - 4) Women Division has six games in one series, The six games of high / low apply to the high rank, when it is a tie. High game will determine
 - 5) Youth Division has six games in one series, The six games of high / low apply to the high rank, when it is a tie. High game will determine

The above tie-breaking procedure apply to all four divisions

6) Lane Courtesy

One pair courtesy will be applied

7) Coaching

Coaching is allowed for all bowlers. Only if it is outside from players' bench and allowable when it does not interfere other bowlers. If it considered against this rule, bowler may be sent off after first warning

8) Cheating

Any bowler found guilty of cheating scores, averages eligibility or any other counts, he/she will be immediately disqualified from the entire tournament and unable to receive any benefits from the tournament

9) Media

The tournament is organized by Incheon Metropolitan Bowling Association, no any other media can be used, if not following it, they will be sent off from the stadium immediately

The Tournament rules may be changed by the organizer at any time. Any matters not stated in this rule should be determined by the organizer

► Prize Money

1) Open Division Qualifying Prize Method

Sum up 3 squads in a day (Total 9G will be added up) and prize winner will be awarded according to the ranking
