6. Visa Information

Citizens of the following countries do not require a visa to visit Kuwait and may use National ID Cards to enter the country:

Bahrain, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and UAE

Citizens of the following countries and territories may obtain a visa valid for 3 months on arrival to Kuwait if arriving by air or they may obtain an eVisa before arrival. Should you wish for Kuwait Bowling Federation to process your visa beforehand, you will need to submit the passports to Kuwait Bowling Federation and a visa fee will be charged upon arrival to Kuwait Bowling Center. **We suggest you submit your passports to Kuwait Bowling Federation to avoid waiting in line at the airport.**

All other countries will need visa to Kuwait. Visa applications have to be done by Kuwait Bowling Federation by submitting your passport. We earnestly request that **all passports should be emailed to KBF at least 2 months before the commencement of the championship** to facilitate our processing.

7. Fees

Entry Fee for Delegation

The 25th Asian Tenpin Bowling Championships entry fee is **US\$200** per person for all players, coaches and administrators as well as any extra person in the official delegation. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, participation in Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, and the Victory Banquet.

Entry Fee for Guests/ Supporters

The entry fee for guests and supporters is **US\$150** per person. These fees cover accreditation card, transportation, entry into bowling venue, participation in the Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception, and the Victory Banquet. Guests and supporters may reserve rooms in the official hotel subject to availability of room in the hotel.

Press Officials

Unless they have other duties (another capacity) related to a team or federation at the 25th Asian Tenpin Bowling Championships, there will be no entry fee for accredited press officials except for participation in the Victory Banquet. Banquet fee for press is US\$70 per person.

Visa Fees

The applicable fees for the processing of your visas will be collected upon arrival in Kuwait and shall be paid to Kuwait Bowling Federation
