IBF WORLD CUP 2022 PRESENTED BY QUBICAAMF RULES, FORMAT, SCHEDULE & FAQ

We are:

- The international governing body for the sport of Tenpin, Ninepin and Para Bowling
- Recognised by the International Olympic Committee and International Paralympic Committee
- 115 Member National Federations
- Five Continental Zones

We have identified an opportunity:

- The journey of a bowler starts and ends in a bowling center
- The global stage has not existed
- · Bowling is a sport hidden behind a leisure activity

We need a truly elite international event, an Olympic format event:

- The true test of teamwork
- · Competing as an individual and as a team
- Singles for points and ranking
- Team for the title
- Every game matters
- Endurance of body and mind

The ultimate test:

- World Cup is a test for the best bowling federation in the world.
- World Cup was formerly an individual event
- Starting in 2022, World Cup will re-launch as the best Team event in the world.
- Occurring every other year starting from 2022 we will see the best of the best compete for the most prestigious team award in bowling.
- Working both individually and as a team to create epic battles between nations.
- Gather points for your federation team in the individual round then all come together as one in baker format where strategy plays a huge part of the team composition.

IBF WORLD CUP FORMAT

- Federation vs federation
- Bowler vs Bowler
- Male and female format
- Singles title
- Pools will be dependent on registration after closing date of October 7th 2022
- All bowlers compete in round one (Individual format)
- Ranking points from individual competition to form pool position

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

Eligibility

All current member federations are eligible to participate in the 2022 IBF World Cup presented by QubicaAMF. Federations must be current with their IBF and Zone membership fees. Each federation shall be limited to a team of four athletes of each gender. Federations can only enter one team per gender. Meaning if a nation only has four male or female athletes then they enter only one gender.

Team Format

There will be three rounds of competition.

Round 1 – Individual Competition (Bowlers participating singularly earning points and position for their team)

Round 2 - Teams Matchplay Two pools for Men and One pool for Women

Round 3 - Last 16 (Men only)

Round 4 - Finals (Quarter, Semi, Bronze, Final)

Singles Format

Round 1 – Individual Competition (Bowlers participating singularly earning points and position for their team and the top four from each pool in the Men's Division qualify for the Top 32 and the top 4 from each group in the Women's Division qualify for Top 16)

Round 2 – Singles Top 32 (men) Top 16 (women) bracket matches Round 3 – Finals (Quarter, Semi, Bronze, Final)

IBF World Cup Baker Format:

Athletes in the selected team are assigned to an order per game; 1, 2, 3 and 4.

- Athlete 1 bowls frame 1, 5 & 9.
- Athlete 2 bowls frame 2, 6 & 10.
- Athlete 3 bowls frame 3 & 7.
- Athlete 4 bowls frame 4 & 8.

Baker order must rotate each game (Examples below):

- 1-2-3-4
- 4-1-2-3
- 3-4-1-2
- 2-3-4-1

ROUND ONE - INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION (TEAM & SINGLES)

i.An impartial and random draw will be conducted to place athletes into four groups (Group A, B, C, D), each group containing one athlete per federation.

ii. The number of federations participating is 22 men and 10 Women. Each group in the Men's Division will be divided into 2 pools for the round robin match-play. Each group in the Women's Division will bowl match-play within their group.

22 Men's federations in each group (A,B,C, and D), then further divided via a draw of names into 2 pools. Each pool with 11 athletes. (There will be bye in each pool to ensure each pool bowls the same number of games) 10 Women's federations in each group (A,B,C and D)

iii.Athletes will bowl one game matches in their pool/group according to a predetermined schedule. The last match will be a position round.

iv.Points will be allocated on the following basis;

- Three Points for a win
- One point for a tie
- Zero for a loss

v.At the conclusion of Round 1 there will be a ranking in a global leaderboard combining the scores of each individual athlete as one leaderboard for the nation they represent.

vi. Ties to advance to Round 2, will be broken by a one game roll off between the teams. If there is still a tie a further game will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest combined game during Round 1 will choose the starting lane. If there is still a tie then the second highest game, continuing until the tie is broken.

vii. Ties for positions within leaderboard will be broken by highest last game (combined) in qualification. If a tie still exists, it is broken by highest 2nd last game and so forth until tie is broken.

Example:

Men - 22 federations four groups of 22 (Bowler A, B, C, D assigned to a Group via a draw). Two pools each with 11.

Women – 10 federations four groups of 10 (Bowler A, B, C, D assigned to a Group via a draw).

ROUND TWO TEAM MATCHPLAY POSTIONS 1ST TO 16TH MEN AND 1ST TO 8TH WOMEN

1. The top 16 in the men's division will play 15 matches round robin.

2. The top 8 in the women's division will 2 rounds of round robin matches a total of 14 matches.

3.Each match will be best of three games.

4. Points start from scratch.

5. Points will be allocated on the following basis;

- Three Points for a win
- Zero for a loss

6. All matches will be played using the IBF World Cup baker format.

7. If there is a tie in any game during the round robin matches a 9th 10th frame roll off will be held to be played by the athlete who bowled the 10th frame in the game, repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest ranking, after Round 1, will decide who will bowl first and on which lane the frame will be bowled. If there is still a tie a further 9th 10th frame roll off will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

8. The top eight teams in the men's division at the completion of round two will advance to the quarter finals. The top 4 teams in women's division will advance to the semi-finals.

9.If there is tie for position eight (men), or position 4 (women) then a one game roll off will be played repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest ranking, after Round 1, will decide who will bowl first and on which lane the game will commence. If there is still a tie a further game will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

10.Ties for seeding in the top 16 (men)/8 (women) will be broken by the highest ranked team after qualification.

QUARTER-FINALS MEN'S DIVISION

The top 8 teams from Round 2 will contest the quarter finals.

i. The quarter finals will be contested over best of five games match in accordance with the following schedule.

- QF1 M1: 1 vs 8
- QF2 M2: 2 vs 7
- QF3 M3: 3 vs 6
- QF4 M4: 4 vs 5

ii. The quarter finals will be contested using the IBF World Cup Baker Format.

iii.If there is a tie in any game during the Last 8 a 9th 10th frame roll off will be held, to be played by the athlete who bowled the 10th frame in the game, repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest ranking, after Round 2, will decide who will bowl first and on which lane the frame will be bowled. If there is still a tie a further 9th 10th frame roll off will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

SEMI-FINALS

i. The winners of the Quarterfinals in the men's division and the top 4 teams after round 2 in the women's division will advance to the Semi-final.

ii.The Semi-finals will be contested over a best of five games match in accordance with the following schedule.

Men

- SF1: M5: Winner M1 vs Winner M4
- SF2: M6: Winner M2 vs Winner M3

Women

- SF1: 1 v 4
- SF2: 2 v 3

iii. The Semi-Finals will be contested using the IBF World Cup Baker Format.

iv. If there is a tie in any game during the semi-finals a 9th 10th frame roll off will be held, to be played by the athlete who bowled the 10th frame in the game, repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest ranking, after Round 2, will decide who will bowl first and on which lane the frame will be bowled. If there is still a tie a further 9th 10th frame roll off will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

IBF SINGLES MATCHPLAY

The top 32 bowlers in the men's division and the top 16 bowlers in the women's division from the Round One Qualification will enter into a global bracket format.

The top four bowlers from each pool in each group in the men's division.

The top four bowlers from each group in the women's division.

Each match will be best of 3 games.

BRONZE MEDAL MATCH

i. The losers of the Semi-finals will play a bronze medal match.

ii. The bronze medal match will be contested, over a best of five games match.

Bronze Medal match: Loser SF1 vs Loser SF2

iii.The Bronze Medal match will be contested using the IBF World Cup Baker format

iv.If there is a tie in any game during the semi-finals a 9th 10th frame roll off will be held, to be played by the athlete who bowled the 10th frame in the game, repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest ranking, after Round 2, will decide who will bowl first and on which lane the frame will be bowled. If there is still a tie a further 9th 10th frame roll off will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

FINAL

ii. The winners of the Semi-finals advance to the Final.

ii. The Final will be contested over a best of five games match.

WORLD CUP FINAL: Winner SF1 vs Winner SF2

iii. The Final will be contested using the IBF World Cup Baker format.

iv.If there is a tie in any game during the finals a 9th 10th frame roll off will be held, to be played by the athlete who bowled the 10th frame in the game, repeated until the tie is broken. The team with the highest ranking, after Round 2, will decide who will bowl first and on which lane the frame will be bowled. If there is still a tie a further 9th 10th frame roll off will be held with the starting team and lanes reversed. This will be repeated until the tie is broken.

IBF SHOT CLOCK

i. The following time rules apply and will be strictly enforced during the entire event.

ii.First shot in a frame. When your opponent leaves the approach and you have a full set of pins, you have 30 seconds to complete your shot. The shot is deemed complete in shot clock terms when the ball is fully released and has passed the foul line.

iii.Second shot in a frame. After your first ball has returned to the ball return, you have 30 seconds to complete your shot. The shot is deemed complete in shot clock terms when the ball is fully released and has passed the foul line.

iv.First offence: The shot will count as a foul, nulling any pins knocked down in that shot.

v.Second, and continued offence: The pin count of the whole frame where the offence occurred in will be nulled.


OILING PATTERN
