10. Entry Fee

The IBF Para Bowling World Championships entry fee per person is US\$142/night/person for twin-sharing room and US\$207/night/person for single room.

This fee applies to all members of each delegation, including athletes, coaches, administrators, head of delegations and other officials/chaperones/medical personnels in the delegation. This fee covers Accreditation Card, hotel accommodation plus 3 meals, transportation to and from Hong Kong International Airport and Courtyard by Marriott Hong Kong, transportation to and from hotel to bowling centre, participation in Opening Ceremony, Welcome Reception and the Victory Banquet.

For Visually Impaired athletes, IBSA charges a <u>Euro \notin 25</u> Capitation Fee per athlete. This will be collected upon arrival of the team to Hong Kong.

16. Visa Information

No visa for entry is required for more than 170 countries/regions. However, the visa-free period may vary among different countries/regions. All countries/ regions should confirm visa information independently by checking "Part II of Visit Visa/ Entry Permit Requirements for the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region" from the Immigration Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/visit-transit/visit-visa-entry-permit.html.

Application form could be found in <u>www.immd.gov.hk/eng/forms/hk-visas/visit-transit.html</u>. The application process may take more than 6 weeks' time. All visa applications must be submitted to HKCTBC at least 2 months before the commencement of the championship to facilitate our processing with the HKSAR Immigration Department and NOT to the Chinese Embassy in your country/regions. We earnestly request that all filled out forms should be emailed to HKCTBC.

17. National Anthem and Flags

All participating federations are reminded to bring along **4 national flags (1 meter x 2 meters)** and **1 USB / CD of their national anthem** which should be delivered to the Tournament Office upon arrival at Kai Tak Sports Park Bowling Centre.

18. Insurance

Participants must arrange their own travel, health and personal accident insurance. Organizer would take no responsibility in respect of all medical and risks associated with the organization and staging of the championship.
