

KUALA LUMPUR INTERNATIONAL OPEN BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025 25 MAY – 1 JUNE

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZATION & SANCTION

The Kuala Lumpur International Open Bowling Championships 2025(KLIO25) is organized by Kuala Lumpur Tenpin Bowling Association (KLTBA) and sanctioned by Malaysian Tenpin Bowling Congress(MTBC) and Asian Bowling Federation (ABF). It will be conducted in accordance to World Bowling Playing Rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY

All current MTBC members of good standing bowlers accredited by their respective states association and ABF affiliates are eligible to participate in this Championship. All local participants must show proof by producing their membership cards or receipts for examination if requested. All overseas participants must obtain clearance from their respective National Tenpin Bowling Associations.

3. AVERAGES

For local participants, grading will be based on Junior Circuit and the official averages of MTBC (74) and bowler without established average must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective Associations. Overseas bowlers must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective National Bowling association or Congress.

All Youth categories does not need to bowl for Singles event. The first attempt for Graded Division and Open Division must be a Singles event. No refund shall be made after an entry has been registered and accepted.

5. EVENTS & MASTERS

5.1 YOUTH GIRLS AND BOYS U12

This event open to 120 bowlers of boys or girls born in 2013 or after on the first come first serve basis. Bowlers will bowl 6 games scratch on 26st May 2025 and total pinfalls to decide the winners. The tournament director(s) reserve the rights to increase or decrease the number participation in each category as he/she deems fit to for both Youth Boys and Girls U-12.

Check in at 9.00am to 9.30am. Roll off at 10am

5.2 YOUTH GIRLS GRADED

Qualifying scores based on best of 2 MQ.

This event open to girls born in 2004 or after and averaging 189 and below.

Top 15 girls will bowl 8 games scratch and total pinfalls to decide the winners.

Last squad for qualifying is on 29th May 2025 at 2.30pm.

Final on 29th May 2025. Check in at 8.00pm – 8.45pm. Roll off at 9.00pm. Reserves will be called at 8.46pm.

5.3 YOUTH BOYS GRADED

Qualifying scores based on best of 2 MQ.

This event open to boys born 2004 and after and averaging 194 and below.

Top 18 boys will bowl 8 games scratch and total pinfalls to decide the winners.

Last squad for qualifying is on 29th May 2025 at 2.30pm.

Final on 29th May 2025. Check in at 8.00pm – 8.45pm. Roll off at 9.00pm. Reserves will be called at 8.46pm.

5.4 YOUTH GIRLS OPEN

Qualifying scores based on best of 2 MQ.

This event open to girls born 2004 and after.

Top 18 girls finalists will bowl 8 games scratch and total pinfalls to decide the winners.

Last squad for qualifyng is on 24th May 2024 at 2.30pm

Final on 24th May 2024. Check in at 8.00pm – 8.45pm. Roll off at 9.00pm. Reserves will be called at 8.46pm.

5.5 YOUTH BOYS OPEN

Qualifying scores based on best of 2 MQ.

This event open to boys born 2003 and after.

Top 24 boys finalists will bowl 8 games scratch and total pinfalls to decide the winners.

Last squad for qualifying is on 30th May 2025 at 2.30pm

Final on 30th May 2025. Check in at 8.00pm – 8.45pm. Roll off at 9.00pm. Reserves will be called at 8.46pm.

5.6 SENIOR MASTER MEN AND WOMEN

This event is open to 120 men and 60 women born 1975 and before on the first come first serve basis. The tournament director(s) reserve the rights to increase or decrease the number participation in each category as he/she deems fit to for both Senior Master Men and Women. Bowlers aged 55 (born year 1970) will be given a handicap of 5 pins per game and an additional of 1 pin per game for each year from the age of 56 onwards.

Senior Men Bowlers will bowl 6 games on 25th May 2025 and total pinfalls with handicap to decide the winners.

Check in at 9.00am to 9.30am. Roll off at 10am

Senior Women Bowlers will bowl 6 games on the 25th May 2025 and total pinfalls with handicap to decide the winners.

Check in at 1.00pm to 1.30pm, Roll off at 2.30pm.

5.7 GRADED DIVISION

Qualifying scores based on best of 2 MQ.

This event open to all current MTBC members with an average of 190 and below for women and 200 and below for men. Women will be given handicap of 7 pins per game for MQ, Singles and Master finals.

Top 8 women and 28 mixed qualifiers will bowl 8 games and total pinfalls with handicap to decide the winners.

Last squad for qualifying is on 31st May 2025 at 2.30pm

Final on 31st May 2025. Check in at 8.00pm – 8.45pm. Roll off at 9.00pm. Reserves will be called at 8.46pm

5.8 OPEN DIVISION

Qualifying scores bases on best of 2 MQ.

This event open to all current MTBC members and all women bowlers will be given handicap of 7 pins per game for MQ, Singles and Master Finals.

Top 8 women and 28 mixed qualifiers will bowl 8 games and total pinfalls with handicap to decide the winners.

Final on 1st June 2025. Check in at 9.00am – 9.45am. Roll off at 10.00am. Reserves will be called at 9.46am.

6. SQUAD TIMES

If preferred squad times indicated on the entry forms are not available, the Tournament Directors or Assistants reserve the right to reallocate squad times at their discretion. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to open additional squads.

All qualifiers must check with the Tournament Director 24 hours before their final roll-off, to confirm their fixtures and/or check for any changes in the schedule.

7. REGISTRATION OF BOWLING BALLS

It is the bowlers' responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used during the Tournament are verified for correctness of weight and other specifications. If in doubt, the ball may be verified by the Tournament Technical Committee. The Tournament Technical Committee reserves the right to recall any ball(s) for inspection at any time

8. ALTERING OF BOWLING BALL SURFACE (NEW)

8.1 Any use of chemicals MUST be on the "Acceptable List" as listed on Bowl.com website (<https://bowl.com/equipment-specifications/approved,-non-approved-products>). It is not allowed to use anything listed in the "Products Containing Solids or Abrasives" section nor listed in the "Not Acceptable at any time" section. The ball must be wiped clean after any adjustment.

8.2 Bowling ball surface adjustments by hand are acceptable between BLOCKS provided they are done in the designated area and that the adjustment procedure does not delay the bowler's next turn.

Altering the surface of the bowling ball is allowed in a designated area only during the official practice session, during the practice session immediately preceding a competition round, and between competition round (blocks).

Altering Surface is NOT allowed between games or during games. It can only be done after the round or block.

If the surface is adjusted during a game or in between games, the penalty is zero pinfall for that game.

9. TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES

9.1 When a tie occurs for the last place in the Masters' Qualifying, the player with the highest last game of the 2nd best MQ shall determine the positions.

9.2 If a tie exists in (9.1) after the tie-breaker, a one ball roll-off will be utilized and/or repeated until the tie is broken.

9.3 When a tie is registered which will affect the awards of prizes, the prizes will be shared equally among the winners.

10. AWARDS

Prizes in the form of Cash Vouchers will be awarded to the winners.

11. VERIFICATIONS OF SCORES

It is the bowlers' responsibility to ensure that the correct score for each game is recorded in the official score sheet by signing on the official score sheet.

12. BOWLERS ATTIRE

12.1 Bowlers are requested to be dressed for their events with a sense of decorum.

12.2 Men bowlers are not permitted to wear jeans, shorts, singlet and caps while women bowlers are not permitted to wear jeans and cap.

13. PROTEST

13.1 Scores : Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 12 hours of the event. No protest made after the prize presentation will be entertained.

13.2 Eligibility : Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their Assistants within 12 hours of the first infringement.

14. SPECIAL NOTES

The Tournament Directors, or, in his absence, his appointed official on duty, reserves the right to accept or reject any entry as deem fit. Any matters arising which are not covered in these Rules and Regulations will be decided by the Tournament Directors. The decision of the Tournament Directors shall be final. Such appeal should be made in writing and within 12 hours of the decision by any of the above.
